
## **Plant Crib**



## TOFIELDIA PUSILLA / NARTHECIUM OSSIFRAGUM, VEGETATIVE

In flushes in the Scottish mountains, these species may grow beside each other and can appear similar vegetatively.

*Tofieldia pusilla* (Michx.) Pers.: Leaves usually  $25-50 \times 1-3$  mm, minute teeth present along at least one margin ( $\times 20$  lens in silhouette; can also be felt across lips!) giving very narrow transparent margin; usually in the more calcareous flushes.

*Narthecium ossifragum* (L.) Huds.: Leaves usually  $45-200 \times 2-5$  mm, margins entire, smooth, not transparent; usually in the more acidic flushes.
