ACCOMMODATION

Self-catering accommodation is available at The Barn from Monday at 4.00 pm until 10.30 am on Friday at the price quoted. Full facilities for making breakfast are provided but you will need to bring your own provisions.

The self-catering accommodation is organised into cottages, each with a sitting area and kitchen in addition to the bedrooms. Two rooms have bunk beds and disabled access is available for one room.

As accommodation is limited at The Barn and is offered for the full conference duration, we have also reserved Bed and Breakfast accommodation at The Beacons Guesthouse in Brecon which has ample private parking.
