SILWOOD PARK, ASCOT

The flora of Silwood Park has been recorded year-round, multiple times per week since 1979. The upshot of this unusually high recording-effort is that it appears as if the four 1-km squares that contain Silwood Park (SU 9368, 9369, 9468 and 9469) support much higher species richness than do other parts of Berkshire. This may well be true for exotic trees (e.g. the arboretum at Silwood contains more than 200 planted species, hybrids and cultivars of *Quercus*), but there is no reason to think that the native flora of Silwood is particularly rich. What these data tell us is that scores or even hundreds of species that come and go naturally in other parts of Berkshire do so probably unobserved and certainly undocumented. This under-recording is likely to be least important for long-lived, conspicuous evergreen trees, and most important for small, ephemeral annual species especially those that are unfamiliar aliens or garden escapees.

Since its inception, the Botanical Society has always frowned upon the recoding of planted individuals. Many recorders restrict their activities entirely to what they regard as natural habitats, and shy away completely from parks and gardens. Because I am interested in the floras of towns and cities, I have never subscribed to this view. One way or another, all of the plants in towns owe their presence to people: most of them were planted on purpose, a few are cherished as remnants of semi-natural vegetation, and the others (the uninvited, if you like) just haven't been got rid of yet. I record them all, to as high a level of taxonomic resolution as I can achieve: sometimes only to genus, but usually to species, and occasionally to cultivar (specially for highly bred taxa like *Narcissus* where the parentage is much less likely to be known with certainty than the cultivar name).

The checklist is annotated only for those taxa that have shown significant change in their distribution or abundance since 2000. Otherwise, distribution and abundance are as recorded in The Flora of Berkshire (2005).
