

## BSBI Award for an outstanding contribution to British and Irish Botany

The BSBI is now accepting nominations for the 2023 Awards that advance the understanding and appreciation of the British and Irish Flora.

## Eligibility for award categories:

The awards can be given to \*anyone who is a BSBI member or a group which includes BSBI members.

The Nominee (or a representative of the Group) must give their written consent to being nominated – see below.

The Awards Committee will consider the significance of the contribution made to **advancing the understanding and appreciation of the British and Irish flora over a sustained period** by individuals who have shown outstanding and committed devotion that align with BSBI's objectives. For example, through teaching or research (including ecology, taxonomy, distribution or genetics), engagement work through giving talks, and lectures, writing and contributing to books and articles, producing and delivering training or significant support to the running of the Society.

This national award is aimed at those whose influence is at the whole Society level and whose name may already be well-known by the majority of members across the Society.

If you wish to nominate more than one person/ group for this award, please use a separate form for each nominee.

If you also wish to nominate a person/ group in the separate 'Contribution to botany in your area' category, please use the relevant nomination form.

Any BSBI member, group (which includes BSBI members) or committee is eligible to make nominations, **you may even nominate yourself!** \*However, BSBI staff, Hon. Officers and trustees are NOT eligible for Awards.

Nominations close on **31<sup>st</sup> December**. The Awards Committee may ask for supplementary material to be supplied for short-listed candidates.

The Awards will be announced in the April issue of BSBI News, on the BSBI website, eNewsletters and on our social media platforms.
