<u>Saturday, May 25th</u> to visit Moore Reserve SJ577854 to relocate *Pyrola rotundifolia*. Other species previously recorded at this site include *Filago minima, trifolium aureum* and *Carex vulpinoidea*. Park by roadside to left or right of crossroads.

<u>Saturday</u>, <u>June 29th</u> to visit Red Rock Sands, Wirral. *Parking tbc – any local information would be gratefully received*.

<u>Saturday, 27th July</u> to visit Pickmere to check out Cowbane, *Cicuta virosa*. *Parking tbc - any local information would be gratefully received*.

<u>Saturday</u>, 17th <u>August</u> to visit Farndon to check how *Mentha x gracilis* is doing and to see how much *S x versicolor* has invaded the river banks. Park at SJ 41201 54422 to walk eastwards along the river.

<u>Saturday</u>, 14th <u>September</u> to visit Brown's Bank, Audlem to find Small teasel. Park in layby SJ642429 and walk south.
