



Channel Islands' Top 20



Daisy
A familiar white and yellow flower found in lawns and grassy places.



Red Campion
5-petalled pink flowers and leaves in opposite pairs.



Gorse
Yellow flowers that smell of coconut in the sun. Watch out for the prickly spines!



Smooth Sow-thistle
A dandelion look-alike but stem leaves have pointy bases which wrap around the stem.



Smooth Hawk's-beard
Tall plant with Dandelion-like flowers and leaves that 'clasp' the stem.



Herb Robert
Pink 5-petalled flowers and deeply divided fern-like leaves. It's a bit smelly!



Annual Meadow Grass
A tiny grass. We recommend you submit a photo of this one.



Cat's-ear
Looks similar to a Dandelion but doesn't have a green 'ruff' below the flower, and has very hairy leaves.



Groundsel
Yellow flowers, sometimes in a cluster, with no petals. Weedy places and pavements.



Hogweed
Big divided leaves, hairy stems, white umbrella-shaped or cauliflower-like flowers.



Dandelion
A yellow flower with jagged leaves found in lawns, grassy places and flowerbeds.



Hairy Bittercress
Clusters of tiny white four-petalled flowers (with four stamens) and upright seedpods.



Brambles
5-petalled pink or white flowers. Watch out for the thorns!



Common Field-speedwell
Flower with four blue petals and hairy 'toothed' leaves.



Sweet Violet
Usually violet in colour, occasionally white, with a sweet scent and tiny hairs on the stem and leaf stalks.



Primrose
Pale yellow flower with a darker centre; crinkly leaves.



Musk Stork's-bill
5-petalled Geranium-like flowers; whole plant covered in sticky hairs.



Annual Mercury
Shiny green leaves and clusters of tiny whitish flowers.



Winter Heliotrope
Beautifully scented purple flowers and big heart-shaped leaves.



Lesser Celandine
Yellow Buttercup-like flowers with 7-12 petals and glossy heart-shaped leaves.
