



## Ireland's Top 20





Daisy A familiar white and yellow flower found in lawns and grassy places.



**Creeping Buttercup** Five yellow petals and look for a long groove down the flower-stalk; jagged leaves with pale marks.



**Yarrow** Lots of tiny white flowers clustered into an umbrella shape. Leaves very feathery



**Dandelion** A yellow flower with jagged leaves found in lawns, grassy places and flowerbeds.



Hogweed Big divided leaves, hairy stems, white umbrellashaped or cauliflowerlike flowers.



**Lesser Celandine** Yellow Buttercup-like flowers with 7-12 petals and glossy heartshaped leaves.



Groundsel

Yellow flowers, sometimes in a cluster, with no petals. Weedy places and pavements.



**Herb Robert** 

Pink 5-petalled flowers like leaves.



**Red Clover** 

Distinctive flowers with 3-lobed leaves immediately below the flowerhead.



Gorse

Yellow flowers that smell of coconut in the sun. Watch out for the prickly spines!



and deeply divided fern-It's a bit smelly!



**Hairy Bittercress** 

Clusters of tiny white four-petalled flowers (with four stamens) and upright seedpods.



**Annual Meadow** Grass

A tiny grass. We recommend you submit a photo of this one.



**Ivy-leaved Toadflax** 

Lilac flowers and ivyshaped leaves, grows out of walls and on gravel.



**Oxeye Daisy** 

Looks like a very big daisy but with leaves growing up the stem, not in a rosette.



Winter Heliotrope

Beautifully scented purple flowers and big heart-shaped leaves.



**Petty Spurge** 

Tiny, green-yellow, seaanemone-like flowers are cupped by green, leaf-like 'bracts'.



**Red Dead-nettle** 

Leaves like a nettle but with obvious pinkish flowers.

It doesn't sting!



**Smooth Sow**thistle

A dandelion look-alike but stem leaves have pointy bases which wrap around the stem.



**Common Ragwort** 

A tall plant with clusters of bright yellow daisy-like flowers.



**Nipplewort** 

Multiple small yellow flowerheads on a tall stem. Leaves with little teeth on edges.
