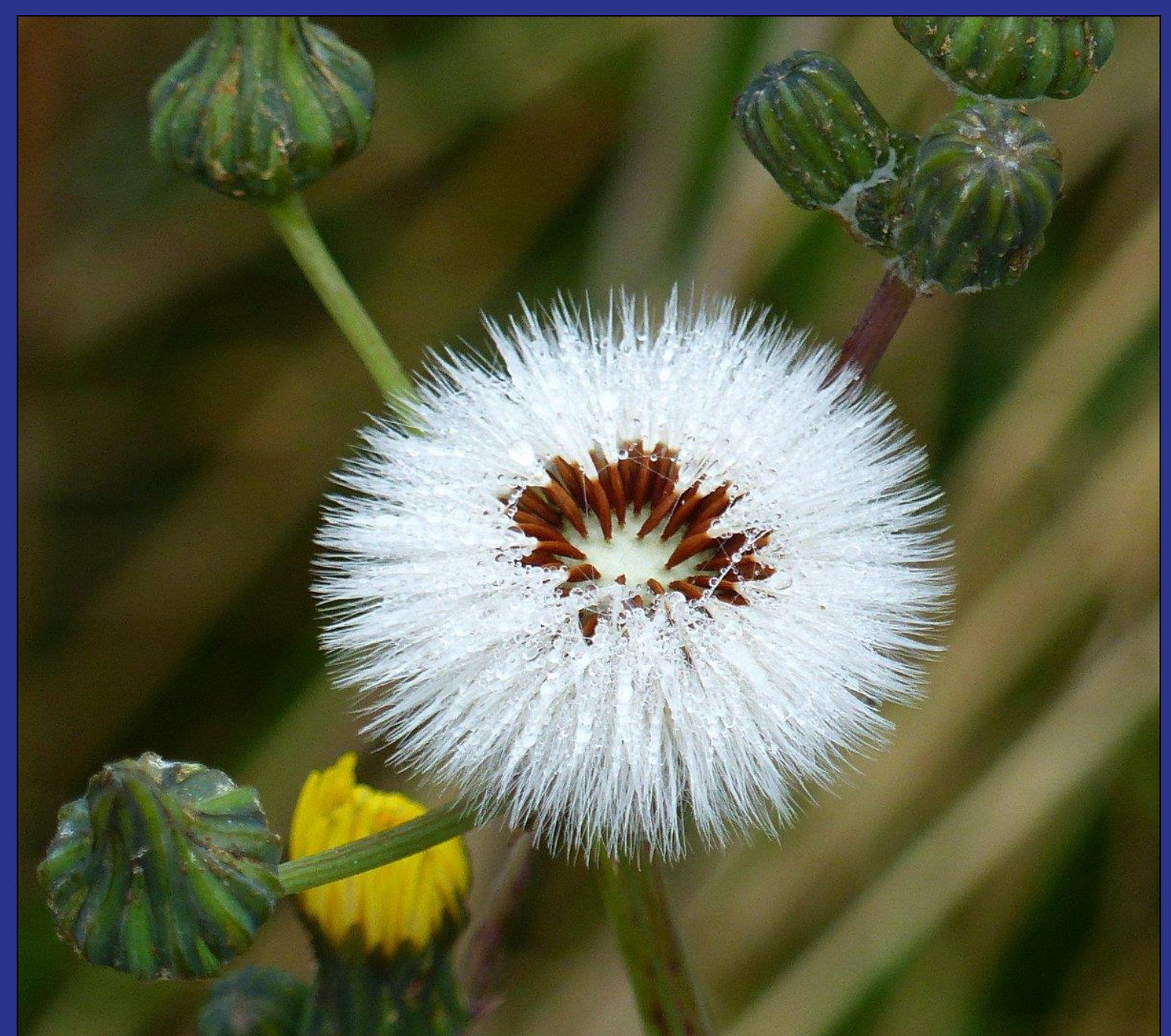
How many wild flowers will be in bloom at midwinter? Help us find out by joining our annual **New Year Plant Hunt**.
