## **Editorial**

It's road verge cutting time of year again and council financial cutbacks in Carmarthenshire (and, no doubt, in other parts of Wales) have apparently spawned many complaints of grass being left uncut. There always appears to be an outspoken lobby of complaining voices but it would be interesting to know exactly how many people actually prefer to see wild flowers rather than the brown, unsightly mowings left to rot by the contractors.

Our County Biodiversity Officer urgently sought our assistance in providing detailed species lists for several of the particularly contentious verges as evidence of their biodiversity value. Despite being currently in Scotland at the time, we were able to abstract the relevant information from the database on the laptop we had with us. Quite apart from the Bee Orchids which grace one roundabout and the hundreds of Southern Marsh-orchids which grow on many verges and which incidentally the mowers recognise as 'wild flowers' so are instructed to leave uncut, the verges support a great variety of species of great value in maintaining populations of pollinating insects.

Local authorities elsewhere have taken on a more relaxed cutting regime to both reduce costs and to benefit biodiversity, subject, of course, to safety and other considerations. Longer grass, and the range of flowers contained in such areas, provide nectar sources for many butterflies, moths and bumblebees, all of which have declined in recent years.

Apart from the destruction of the plants before they have a chance to set seed, too frequent mowing flies in the face of the recently published Welsh Government Action Plan for Pollinators, the stated aims of which are 'to reduce, and reverse, the decline in wild and managed pollinator populations. Pollinators are an essential part of our environment. Honeybees are the main managed pollinator of crops...whilst wild pollinators include bumblebees and butterflies [and] are also important pollinators for crops like fruit, oil seed rape, clovers, which help to improve pastures for livestock grazing and wild flowers. They contribute to the diversity of plant species, habitats and wildlife. This provides food, makes Wales a better place for people to enjoy and visit and contributes to our economy.'

The increased numbers of beneficial and other insects also provide sustenance for many declining birds, particularly in an urban or urban-edge context.

This message might be reinforced if more people were urged to lobby their local councillors to speak out for a more relaxed mowing regime - as well, in many cases, to educate the less informed and less sympathetic councillors themselves who may appear unwilling to consider embracing modified practices which enhance biodiversity.

Due to matters beyond our control this issue of the Bulletin is being published later than usual. Much of this issue is taken up by Welsh Plant Records although we also include a couple of short articles - we're always grateful to receive contributions. We hope you will enjoy reading it.

The 51<sup>st</sup>AGM of BSBI Wales, held at The Bulkeley Hotel, Beaumaris, Anglesey on Friday 14th June 2013 at 9:30am.

#### 1 Welcome

The Chair, Delyth Williams, addressed all assembled, firstly in Welsh and then in English, to The Bulkeley Hotel. She welcomed not only the members from Wales but also those from the west, over the water, and those from the east, over the border.

There were 29 members present, resident in Wales and eligible to vote, including the Chair, Secretary and Treasurer.

#### 3. Minutes of 2012 AGM

Minutes of the 50<sup>th</sup> Annual General Meeting held at Bryn Howel Hotel, Trefor, Llangollen on Thursday 21st June 2012 were printed in Welsh Bulletin No.92, pp. 6-8.

After Margaret Perring pointed out that the reference to "Bwlch Arms" for the 2013 AGM on page 7 should read "Bulkeley Hotel", the meeting agreed that the minutes were a true record and were signed by the Chair.

## 4. Matters Arising

There were no matters arising.

#### 5. Chairman's Statement

Delyth Williams thanked the officers, the Committee members and those who have organised meetings for all their hard work during the year. She then made special mention of Paul Green who has stepped in as Welsh Officer to cover Polly Spencer-Vellacott's maternity leave but is in hospital following surgery this week. Best wishes were sent to Paul and a get-well card circulated for signing.

Delyth also thanked all those who volunteer to lead field meetings and went on to thank Ian and Pippa Bonner for their excellent organisation of both this AGM and the national AGM immediately preceding it. Sarah Stille who is stepping-down from Treasurer at this AGM was then thanked for her committed work. Delyth then reported that John Crellin is now working with Mike Porter as joint Breconshire VCR and that Goronwy Wynne will deliver the key lecture this evening (it had been planned for last year's AGM but illness had prevented Goronwy from attending).

Delyth concluded by congratulating Trevor Evans and Marjorie Wainwright on each being awarded the honour of *Recorder Emeritus* by the BSBI for their long and excellent service as VCRs for Monmouthshire and Montgomeryshire respectively.

## 6. Hon. Secretary's Report

Richard Pryce echoed Delyth's thanks and also thanked her, Ian and Pippa and all those involved in the organisation of this Welsh AGM. He thanked Sarah for her work as both Treasurer and Meetings Secretary, and drew attention to the eight

further meetings in this year's calendar and said that Sarah's Merioneth recording meeting at Caerdeon had been very successful in assisting with the ongoing recording of the county's flora.

He commended the Welsh Bulletin to the members present and reminded them that it is also available to non-Welsh residents at £2 per copy, from Kath Slade or Sally Whyman at AC-NMW. The most recent issue was only delivered a few days ago, having been produced at a difficult time due to Museum upheavals. He drew attention to an error in *Welsh Plant Records* where Trevor Evans' name had appeared instead of Elsa Wood and Stephanie Tyler. He also appealed for contributions to future issues, which is produced twice per year and articles for the next issue (January 2014) would be required by November 2013.

Richard then spoke about the Welsh Officer post and again conveyed our best wishes to Paul Green and thanked Andy Jones for offering to carry out species monitoring and complete TPP forms for species including *Antennaria dioica*, *Trollius europaeus* and *Asplenium viride* in Paul's absence. He also extended a welcome-back to Polly when she returns from maternity leave. He went on to inform the meeting that Trevor Dines of Plantlife had used VCR data to complete an inventory of sites in Wales where Section 42 plant species occur, and thanked both Trevor and the VCRs for undertaking this task.

Richard again thanked Ian Bonner for his continued involvement in Welsh Committee matters despite the additional pressure of carrying out his duties as BSBI President. IRB responded, saying that it was a team effort for field meetings, etc.

Finally Richard reminded the meeting that those attending the evening meal would be presented with free wine, courtesy of Cdr John Topp's legacy which he specifically designated for this.

## Sagina maritima (Sea Pearlwort) along the A55 on Anglesey

The last time I drove along the A55 on Anglesey there was so much snow I thought I would never reach Holyhead and the ferry across to Dublin. This year at the end of April it was full sun and Anglesey was looking stunning!

As soon as I saw the narrow strip along the margin of the A55 covered in *Cochlearia danica* (Danish Scurvygrass), the botany part of my brain kicked in, and said *Sagina maritima* (Sea Pearlwort). There was no way I was going to walk along such a busy road, but instead chose to stop at each layby.

I started my hunt at a layby on the Caernarvonshire side of the Menai Strait and from here found the Sea Pearlwort in every layby until the road ended at Holyhead (see images 5 and 6 on inside back cover). Along the roadside is a foot wide strip of gravel generally covered with Danish Surveygrass. Where the gravel was the dominant ground cover the Sea Pearlwort was rare, but where a thin layer of soil was starting to form the Sea Pearlwort formed a dense carpet. *Sagina procumbens* (Procumbent Pearlwort) was often abundant, and at one layby *Sagina apetala* (Annual Pearlwort) also grew with the other two Pearlworts. Another species I was surprised to see in this habitat was *Myosotis discolor* (Changing Forget-me-not), not easy to spot from a speeding car!

Sea Pearlwort is a dirty green/brown colour as is Annual Pearlwort which does not help with ID much. Sea Pearlwort could be mistaken as a very robust form of Annual Pearlwort, again not much help for ID. If you read the descriptions of both species, it is a wonder they can ever be told apart, as there is very little difference apart from the fact that Annual Pearlwort has a longer point at the tip of the leaf. Again not much help for ID. The 'jizz' or overall look of a plant, helps me much of the time — Sea Pearlwort as a rule will have a rosette of leaves with the flowering stems semi prostrate. While Annual Pearlwort has a rosette, the flowering stems tend to stand upright, often truly erect. Procumbent Pearlwort hopefully should be easier to ID as it is a perennial, often forming patches and is lime green in colour.

Do keep an eye out for Sea Pearlwort along the roads in Wales as there are very few inland records. It must be along other Welsh roads!

## Happy Birthday SEWBReC!

In February this year, the South East Wales Biodiversity Records Centre (SEWBReC) had their 10th anniversary. The usually Glamorgan Recorders and the Gwent Recorders Fora were combined into a special joint event for the occasion at the SOAR centre Pen-y-Graig, Rhondda. It was well attended with over 100 people signing up (which may well have been something to do with the birthday cake SEWBReC promised).

SEWBReC covers Glamorgan and Gwent, plus a small part of Breconshire vice-county 42, and has over 2.5 million wildlife records on their database. These data are drawn upon by consultants when reporting on sites for planning applications. More wildlife records in the system mean that more is known about sites and species in order to make informed decisions on future land developments.

Just before lunch, we were treated to a Pointless-style quiz\* with questions such as:

- Name the birds from the photo (a female Blackcap being the bird the least number of people recognised),
- Name a country Alfred Russel Wallace visited (To commemorate the 100th anniversary of his death. This tied in nicely with a talk later by Julian Carter from Amgueddfa Cymru),
- Name the most common plant on the database (*Holcus lanatus*, Yorkshire Fog),
- Name the year that SEWBReC was launched (yes the answer was 2004, although a surprisingly low number of people got this right despite it being the 10th anniversary event!)

SEWBReC highlighted their new online recording software, SEWBReCORD, where people can enter and upload their data where it can then be verified. At the time of writing, this has been very productive, with over 10,000 records entered in the first 6 months. This is a flexible way to get your data to SEWBReC, share your records with others and view graphs and maps of your data. SEWBReC had thought that SEWBReCORD, combined with Square of the Month (used to

highlight poorly recorded monads), had succeeded in erasing the last blank square in the database. Unfortunately, due to a technical hitch, this was only nearly the case. So there are still opportunities to enter the first records for *Holcus lanatus* for some squares!

There was a record number of speakers and it became hard to keep to time. Richard Wistow spoke passionately about the unusual mosaic of habitats on colliery spoil, where acid and alkali loving plants sit side by side. Julian Woodman spoke on the plants of Rhos pasture and Carys Solman encouraged us to visit the Wildlife Trust Nature Reserve at Taf Fechan (near Merthyr).

An award ceremony for outstanding recorders rounded the day off with Barry Stewart the runaway winner for the most records entered in the most number of taxa. As the master of ceremonies (and volunteer Director of SEWBReC) Colin Cheesman said, you have another 10 years to catch up and enter over 200,000 records to overtake him.

# Recent sightings of *Fumaria purpurea* (Purple Ramping-fumitory) in Wales

While walking NW along the B4419 from Moel-y-don (Mermaid Quay) (SH475650) on the BSBI *Taraxacum* Workshop weekend the group came across a patch of *Fumaria bastardii* (Tall Ramping-fumitory) and to our surprise also some *Fumaria purpurea* (Purple Ramping-fumitory). Several Welsh members said that is likely to be the first modern record for Anglesey. Looking up what information I could find this is the first record for Anglesey since 1967 when it was recorded from Red Wharf Bay.

Two days later I was driving along the B5420 in Portaethwy (SH553722), Anglesey, I saw a large patch of *Fumaria* growing on a bank above a wall. I stopped and went back and sure enough it was more *Fumaria purpurea*. Here there was a patch a good 4m long with several hundred flowering/fruiting heads.

Five days later I was in the car with Tim Rich & Ceri Gait, on the edge of Chepstow (ST526932) on the A466. I shouted we have just driven by *Fumaria purpurea*. Coming up to a roundabout I jumped out of the car and collected a piece of the *Fumaria* while Tim found somewhere to pull over. Sure enough it was more *Fumaria purpurea*! This is the first record for Monmouthshire since 1990.

Since I put this article together Elsa Wood & Steph Tyler have found another site in Monmouthshire at Mathern (ST5290) where they had three large plants in the churchyard.

The only post 2000 records I have been able to trace for Wales are from Glamorgan at Llanduff (ST1577) in 2005 and Oxwich (SS4986) in 2008, both found by Tim Rich.

While looking on the DDb for Welsh records I noticed there was a 1975 record from Gileston (ST0166) on the Glamorgan coast. As this was not far from Cardiff I popped down to have a look on the 5th May, there were scattered patches around the car park (see images on front cover and inside front cover).

At the end of May I visited Dale (SM810063), Pembrokeshire where *F. purpurea* had been recorded by T.A.W. Davis in 1959. I found one plant along the coast path leading from the car park near the area where it was seen in 1959. Along the road heading south from the same car park I found an extremely large population stretching along the road bank for just over 200m. This is an extremely impressive site, and likely to be the largest population in Wales.

If you see a slightly larger looking *Fumaria muralis* subsp. *boraei* (Common Ramping-fumitory) with pedicels rigidly recurved, which look a little more purple than normal you could be seeing *F. purpurea*. The flowers normally start white, turning purple with age. The only other species of *Fumaria* in Wales with recurved pedicels is *Fumaria capreolata* (White Ramping-fumitory), this has white flowers, with a purple tip.

Since our last update in Welsh Bulletin No. 93 we have both been very busy with a variety of topics, but mainly Rare Plant Registers and getting ready for rare plant monitoring across Wales this summer.

We had run three very successful meetings for BSBI Wales by the end of April. We kicked off the field meeting season with a day in Castle Wood, near Ruthin, Denbighshire, looking at winter tree identification – nine members turned up in pouring rain at the beginning of March, but luckily the weather improved. We saw a good variety of conifers and looked closely at a lot of broadleaved species' buds. The second meeting was an open day to visit the Welsh National Herbarium in National Museum Cardiff. Members met the curators and learnt how to press and mount specimens. They were also given collection tours of the vascular plants, bryophytes, algae, fungi and lichens.

The third meeting was based at Treborth Botanic Garden (part of Bangor University) to learn about Dandelions over three days. We started with an introduction by Nigel Brown on the history of the Treborth Botanic Garden. This was followed by a talk by Tim Rich on dandelions including how to collect and preserve specimens. If this wasn't enough to scare us off from looking at dandelions John Richards took us on a dandelion walk. Our first species we looked at was *Taraxacum wallonicum*, our first new dandelion for Caernarvonshire. We continued looking at dandelions until around 4.30pm when the rain got the better of us. Ceri Gait was in charge of labelling and bagging all the new county records we had seen on our walk.

The evening session was spent pressing the specimens we had collected. The following day we headed into Anglesey where we visited Newborough Warren, Aberffraw and Moel-y-don (Mermaid Quay). John Richards didn't recognise immediately *Taraxacum richardsianum*, a dandelion named after him to the amusement of all present. 29 species of *Taraxacum* were new to Anglesey. Our last day was spent in Caernarvonshire where we walked around a meadow on the

edge of a small industrial estate. Here we saw many species of *Taraxacum* we had not seen previously. Over 30 species of *Taraxacum* were added to Caernarvonshire. The meeting was finished with a visit to the Great Orme where the dandelions were rather over their best. Instead, Wendy McCarthy gave us a tour of all the rare species to be seen on the Great Orme.

Paul stayed on after the workshop to spend three days surveying all the known *Taraxacum palustre* sites on Anglesey. It was found at four out of the six known sites, Newborough Warren being the best with several thousand individual plants.

The four main species we plan to survey this year are: Antennaria dioica (Mountain Everlasting), Hammarbya paludosa (Bog Orchid), Pseudorchis albida (Small-white Orchid) and Trollius europaeus (Globeflower). But as some counties don't have many sites or all the sites for these species have been surveyed in recent years we are planning to survey other rare county species, generally on SSSIs, but also rare county species at the request of the vice-county recorder.

As some people will be aware, Polly is going to be taking maternity leave again from mid-July, but Paul will once again be working full-time and we are confident that a full service will be maintained!

## Welsh Plant Records 2013

Welsh Plant Records are compiled by Stephen Coker, Mountain Grove. Clarbeston Road. Haverfordwest, Pembs. SA63 4SG, from reports of BSBI vicecounty Recorders to whom records should be sent. Plants are listed for each vicecounty in the order of D.H. Kent's List of Vascular Plants of the British Isles (1992) and Supplements 1, 2 & 3 (1996 & 2000) the number in those lists preceding the name so that names changed since 1996 can be given without giving the former name. Rye Brome is an archaeophyte, probably brought to Britain with wheat and rye crop seeds. Until the introduction of efficient seed cleaning methods, Rye Brome seeds were common cereal contaminants. It has evolved to mimic the cereal crops with which it grows, so that the spikelets that contain the seeds (or grain) disarticulate (break up) and release the seed at exactly the right time to ensure collection with the cereal harvest. Occasionally, Rye harvests contained so much contaminating seed that the flour was spoiled by a characteristic bitter taste. According to Cope & Gray (in *Grasses of the British Isles*), this is where the name Cheat Grass originated. With the advent of efficient seed 'cleaning', Rye Brome became less common as an arable weed and decreased greatly in abundance. It seems to be making a comeback.

**8:** *Persicaria minor* (Y Dinboeth Fach or Small Water-pepper). Our best-attended recording meeting of the year at Llangasty on Llangors lake encountered a large population of "unusual *Persicaria*" on the shore and a prolonged debate ensued among the several experts present. At first it was thought to be *Persicaria mitis*, which would be the first record since 1927 but 24 hours later Paul Green contacted me to say it must be *P. minor*, a first record since 1975, albeit slightly unusual material.
