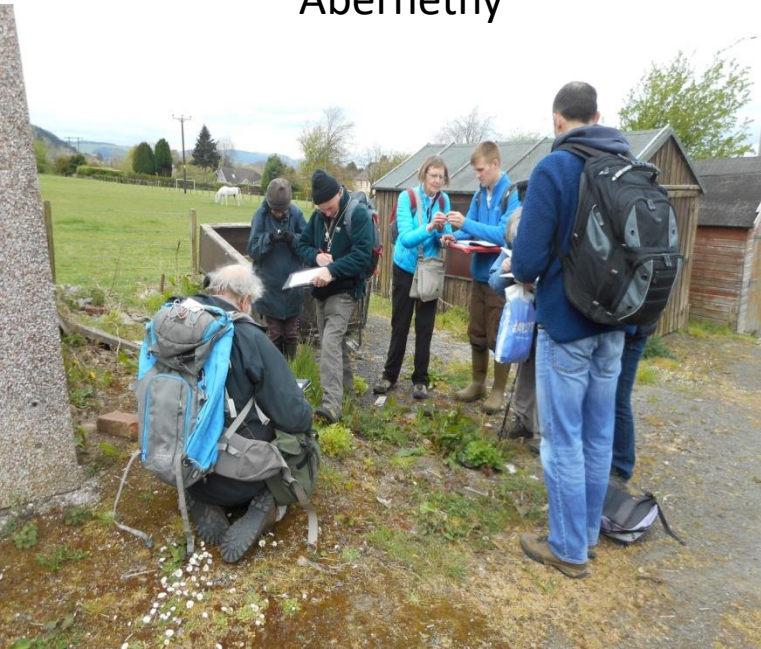

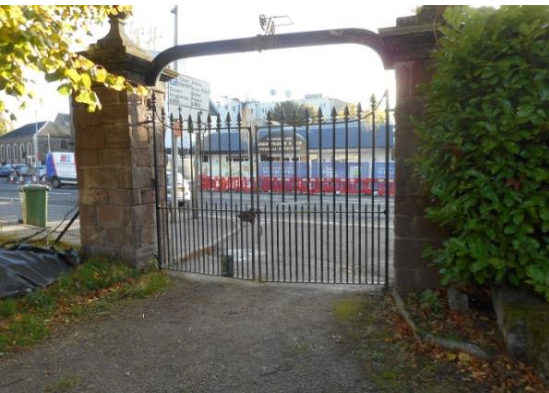

URBAN FLORA

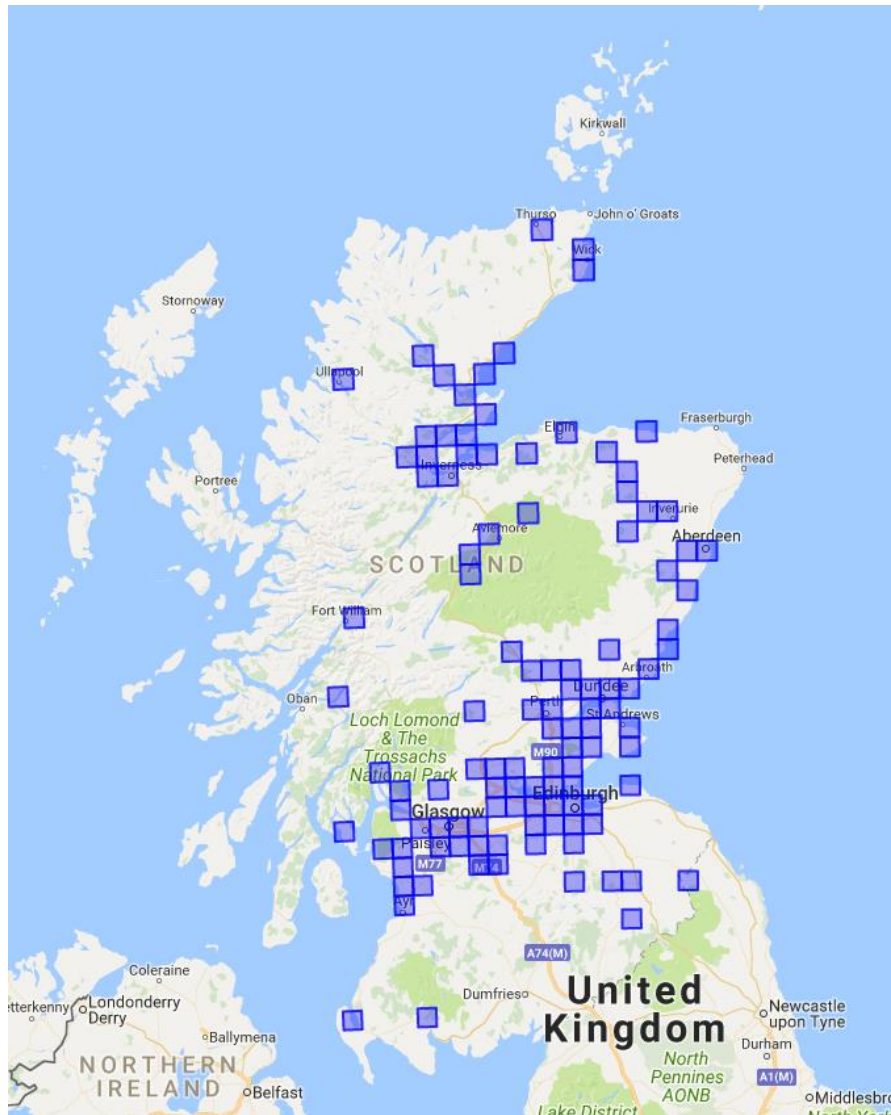
- Cities and towns with populations of 1000+

Common things occur commonly

- 1 *Bellis perennis*
- 2 *Ranunculus repens*
- 3 *Senecio vulgaris*
- 4 *Trifolium repens*
- 5 *Epilobium montanum*
- 6 *Galium aparine*
- 7 *Chamerion angustifolium*
- 8 *Urtica dioica*
- 9 *Poa annua*
- 10 *Plantago lanceolata*



EASTER ROSS VC106

- 11 towns of 1000+
- Approximately 1,100 species of vascular plant recorded. 55 found in urban centres and not elsewhere (mainly neophytes)
- Rare Plants Register. 32 species found in urban areas.
- Approx 50% of species have been recorded in urban areas
- Don't forget to look in your street

- In 2017 in Easter Ross (VC106) I found *Alchemilla alpina*, *Saxifraga stellaris*, *Saxifraga aizoides*, *Minuartia sedoides*, *Oxyria digyna*, *Epilobium anagallidifolium* and *Silene acaulis* at the bottom of the hill
