Starting Time



Getting there

Veune: The National Botanic Gardens, Glasnevin, Dublin, D09 VY63 (see map below). Parking is limited and a charge applies, so please consider car sharing or using public transport if you possibly can.

- Buses run from the city centre to the Botanic Gardens at frequent intervals (Dublin Bus routes 4, 9, 83 and 155 pass by or near the Gardens)
- The Gardens are a c. 25 minute walk from Drumcondra train station.
