## Top 20!



**Daisy**  
A familiar white and yellow flower found in lawns and grassy places.



**Hogweed**  
Big divided leaves, hairy stems, white umbrella-shaped or cauliflower-like flowers.



**Dandelion**  
A yellow flower with jagged leaves found in lawns, grassy places and flowerbeds.



**Petty Spurge**  
Tiny, green-yellow, sea-anemone-like flowers are cupped by green, leaf-like 'bracts'.



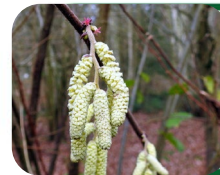
**Yarrow**  
Lots of tiny white flowers clustered into an umbrella shape. Leaves very feathery.



**Groundsel**  
Yellow flowers, sometimes in a cluster, with no petals. Pavements, weedy places.



**Smooth Sow-thistle**  
A dandelion look-alike but stem leaves have pointy bases which wrap around the stem.



**Hazel**  
A small tree with many branches and yellow dangly (male) catkins and tiny red (female) flowers.



**Annual Meadow Grass**  
A tiny grass. We recommend you submit a photo of this one!



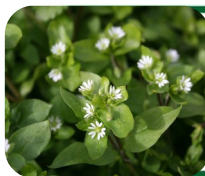
**Gorse**  
Yellow flowers that smell of coconut in the sun. Watch out for the prickly spines!



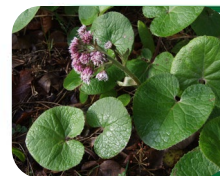
**Herb Robert**  
Pink 5-petalled flowers and deeply divided fern-like leaves. It's a bit smelly!



**White Dead-nettle**  
Leaves like a nettle but with an obvious ring of white flowers. It doesn't sting.



**Common Chickweed**  
White flowers with ten petals. A neat line of hairs on the stem that changes sides between leaves.



**Winter Heliotrope**  
Beautifully scented purple flowers and big heart-shaped leaves.



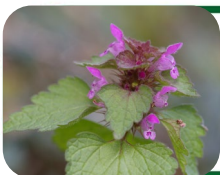
**Shepherd's-purse**  
A cluster of small white flowers, each with 4 petals, and distinctive heart-shaped seed pods.



**Common Field-speedwell**  
Flower with four blue petals and hairy 'toothed' leaves.



**Nipplewort**  
Multiple small yellow flowerheads on a tall stem. Leaves with little teeth on edges.



**Red Dead-nettle**  
Leaves like a nettle but with obvious pinkish flowers. It doesn't sting.



**Ivy-leaved Toadflax**  
Lilac flowers and ivy-shaped leaves, grows out of walls and on gravel.



**Hairy Bittercress**  
Clusters of tiny white four-petalled flowers (with four stamens) and upright seedpods.
